**Treasurer's Report:** BNC account = \$11,669.67 School account = \$0.25

**Coaches Comments:**

- Open gym starts October 27 from 7:00-9:00.
- Practice starts on November 23.
- Varsity can have 3 non-conference games. Therefore, 2 games in Rapid City might be added January 16 for sophomore and JV/Varsity. Legacy already has 2 non-conference games scheduled in December.
- Coach suggested selling autographed t-shirts this season.
- Hopefully there will be 3 freshman coaches this year. Last year there were 2 freshman coaches.
- Coach Horner is checking into a Shooting Machine. He discussed *Krossover*, a sports video analysis software, and *FastDraw*, an iPad app used to build teams plays.
- The early 3:00 varsity game at the Event Center was discussed.
- Preview night is November 28, 2015. This is a boys' basketball function, girls' basketball is invited to participate. All campers attend from 1:00-2:00. Scrimmages start at 2:00.

**Old Business:**

- Committees – Committees will be co-chaired by junior or sophomore parents.
- Hoopster is printed and soon ready.

**New Business:**

- Clothing orders – Dakota Screen Arts orders will be web based, with a link on the Legacy BB website. Two windows will be open to place orders, November 9 - 20 (November 9 is the parent meeting.) and November 27 - December 5.
- Stadium Chairs – Boosters will purchase 20 chairs and have them available for sale at Preview Night.
- 2015-2016 Budget – Review at next meeting. An invoice is needed for the \$300 HUDL payment.

- Calendar Raffle Tickets – Tickets should be ready for the parent meeting. There are 1600 tickets for sale (last year, 1200), \$4000 awarded (last year, \$3000), and drawings will be in January and February.

- Pink Night - February 16 at the Event Center with all other BPS schools, coordinated by Judy Hanson.
- Zappar App – Justin Harmon from *Known in 60* presented Zappar App, an interactive code application with many options. Tom Marchant will follow up, checking on costs and customizing to our needs.
- Game Programs – Program includes both boys and girls. Estimated cost for an 8-page layout (4 pages each), full color throughout is \$.45 per book from United Printing. Photos and schedules will be needed soon. School club members could help with photos. Possibly add Zappar App to programs.

  - Team photo/schedule poster – This will be printed and distributed across town.
  - Team calendar – There will not be calendars this season.

- Sponsor Tiers – A committee will be setting a new tier system with the addition of the video board and possibly the ZAPPAR App.
